PROJECT DESCRIPTION:



Years of chemical exposure had caused significant chemical attack to the concrete walls and floor of the acid containment sump. Work on this project consisted of the following:

- 1. Removal of existing failed coating system.
- 2. Removal of 5' high concrete wall and tile wall along with removal of all contaminated concrete.
- 3. All concrete spalls on the walls were cleaned, formed and patched with concrete.
- Installation of 5 yrd³ of concrete to re-slope the floor to ensure proper drainage.
- 5. Installation of a ChemcCo chemical resistant coating.



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
